We are in receipt of your letter of January 20 wherein you have requested administrative approval of an exception to Order No. R-1427 for two wells, your Berger No. 1 located in Unit B of Section 21, and your Berger No. 5 located in Unit O in Section 14, both in Township 26 North, Range 11 West, San Juan County, New Mexico.

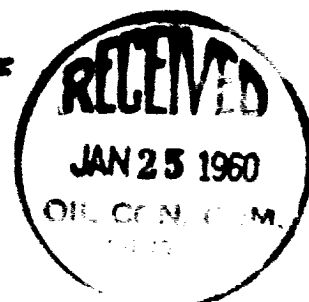
Your application contains no pertinent information as to the volumes of gas which are being produced by these wells, nor does it offer any direct evidence from El Paso Natural Gas Company that they deem connection of these wells as uneconomically feasible.

We would suggest that you contact El Paso Natural Gas Company, requesting that they furnish this Commission with evidence that it is uneconomically feasible to extend their casinghead gas collection system to your Berger lease. Also, you should re-file your application, stating therein all of the pertinent information as to why such flaring would be necessary.
