

THE APPLICATION OF TENNESSEE GAS TRANSMISSION COMPANY FOR PERMISSION TO EFFECT DUAL COMPLETION OF ITS W. O. BERGER WELL NO. 5, LOCATED IN THE SW/4 SE/4 OF SECTION 14, TOWNSHIP 26 NORTH, RANGE 11 WEST, NMPM, SAN JUAN COUNTY, NEW MEXICO, IN SUCH A MANNER AS TO PERMIT THE PRODUCTION OF OIL FROM THE GALLEGOS-GALLUP OIL POOL AND THE PRODUCTION OF GAS FROM AN UNDESIGNATED DAKOTA POOL.

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A (c) Tennessee Gas Transmission Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on December 23, 1959, for permission to dually complete its W. O. Berger Well No. 5, located in the SW/4 SE/4 of Section 14, Township 26 North, Range 11 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of oil from the Gallegos-Gallup Oil Pool and the production of gas from an undesignated Dakota Pool.

Now, on this 13th day of January, 1960, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Sub-section 'c' of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Tennessee Gas Transmission Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its W. O. Berger Well No. 5, located in the SW/4 SE/4 of Section 14, Township 26 North, Range 11 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of oil from the Gallegos-Gallup Oil Pool and the production of gas from an undesignated Dakota Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Section V, Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test Period for the Dakota Zone.

- (1) That a petition has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule
section 10 of Rule 11-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations.
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators
of offset acreage have been duly notified and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period
as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor in pair
correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible
and consistent with good conservation practice.

IT IS THE ORDER OF THE COMMISSION:

That the applicant herein, Tennessee Gas Transmission Company, do
and the same is hereby authorized to drill, complete its W. O. Baker Well
No. 5, located in the SW 1/4 of Section 14, Township 26 North, Range 26
West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit
the production of oil from the Callegos-Callos Oil Pool and the production of
gas from an undesignated Bakers Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and
produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Section V, Rule 11-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall make packer-leakage
tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability
Test Period for the Bakers Pool.
