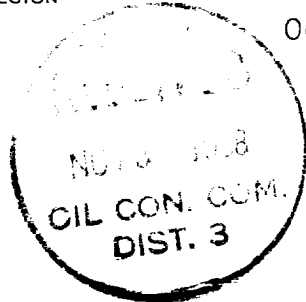

Dear Mr. Arnold:

Thank you for your letter of October 24, 1958, wherein you requested that we give our immediate attention to conducting a packer leakage test on the above subject well.

We have not conducted this packer leakage test due to a misunderstanding on our part. It was our understanding that this test would not be necessary until we asked for an allowable on the second zone. The second zone to be potentialed in this well will be in the Gallegos Dakota and is presently shut-in awaiting a gas pipeline connection, which we anticipate shortly after January 1, 1959. We respectfully request that we be allowed to delay taking this packer leakage test until such time as we secure the above mentioned connection.

In the event this request for delaying this test is not granted, please furnish us with the necessary instructions and forms to comply with your request.
