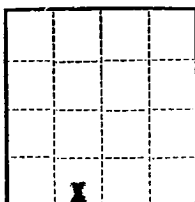

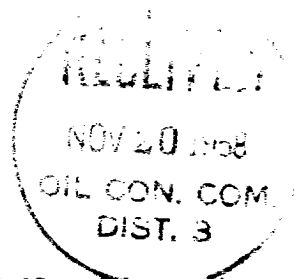
Well No. 1 is located 790 ft. from N line and 1450 ft. from W line of sec. 10

DETAILS OF WORK

O. H. Handel "B" Well no. 1 was spudded on November 2, 1958, and on November 3, 1958, 9-5/8" casing was set at 500 feet with 330 sacks cement. After waiting on cement, casing and water shut-off were tested with 700 pounds pressure for thirty minutes, which held with no drop in pressure.
