2. Perforated 4 shots/ft. from 1955' to 2070' on June 9, 1959.
3. Sand water frac. with 59,000 gallons water & 100,000 lbs. sand.
4. Ran 1", 1.7# siphon line on June 11, 1959, landed at 1956' R.K.B.

5. Well completed June 11, 1959
