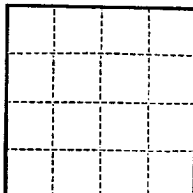

TP 2900', Min. TP 2400', shut down pressure 800'. Inj. rate 99.2 BPM. Time of treatment 21 min.
