- Spudded 12 1/4" surface hole January 24, 1964. Drilled to total depth of 95 feet R.W.B. Ran 3 joints 8 5/8", 24.0#, J-55 casing landed at 88 feet R.K.B. Cemented with 80 sacks regular with 2% Calcium Chloride. Plug down 7:00 A.M. January 25, 1964.
- Nipped up and pressure tested surface casing to 500 psi for 15 minutes. Test OK. Drilled out from under surface casing with 7 7/8" hole on January 25, 1964.
- Drilled 7 7/8" hole to total depth of 2270 feet R.K.B. Ran 77 joints 4 1/2", 9.50#, J-55 casing. Landed at 2264 feet R.K.B. Cemented with 150 sacks 50-50 permix cement with 2% gel. Plug down 2:00 P.M. 1/28/64. Pressured up on plug to 1500 psi. Test okay.
- Total depth 2270'. Plug back total depth 2231'. Perforated 1 shot per foot from 2064-2076 and one hole at 2084, 2096, 2104, 2110, 2155, 2158, and 2162. Total of 19 holes. Sand water and carbon dioxide frac perforations with 40,000# 10-20 mesh sand and 25,200 gallons of water containing 20 tons of liquid carbon dioxide.
- Ran 62 joints 1", 1.70#, JCW tubing. Landed at 2058 feet R.K.B. Completed well February 3, 1964.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices.
