Deliverability Tests that are now required. As there is as yet no pipe
line connection and it looks like it will be sometime in the fall before
there is any hope of such a connection, I was wondering if the filing of

We have received your letter of inquiry regarding your well in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 3-26N-11W, it will not be necessary that you file form C-104 and C-110 or gas well plats on this well until such time as you are ready to produce it. Also it will not be considered delinquent on deliverability test until such time as you start delivering gas. As we receive information regarding tie-ins from the pipeline companies we will know in that manner when the well starts delivering gas.
