
This letter is to inform you that El Paso Natural Gas Company is in the process of drilling and dually completing the following well:

Huerfano Unit No. 99 (DG)

NW 2-26-10

This well will be dually completed in the Dakota and Gallup formations as a gas-gas dual. A production packer will be installed on 2" EUE tubing between the two zones, and a 1 1/4" siphon string will be landed opposite the upper zone. The Dakota gas will be produced through the 2" tubing and the Gallup gas will be produced through the casing. Upon final successful completion a formal application for administrative approval will be submitted to the Oil Conservation Commission in Santa Fe.
