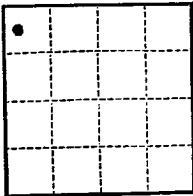

DETAILS OF WORK

The Navajo Tribal 2 #1 well was spudded at 10:15 PM on November 29, 1958. A 12 1/2" hole was drilled to 263' and 9-5/8" casing was cemented at 263' with 100 sx neat cement. Approx. 10 sx of cement were circulated. Presently the well is WOC.
