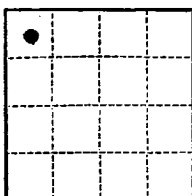

DETAILS OF WORK

Present PWD is 1440', w/perforations at 1522-34 and 1534-42. These parts will be squeezed off. A cut plug will then be placed at 1400-1550, and another 20' plug will be placed at the surface. The location will be marked w/a piece of 1" pipe 10' long. Six ft. of the pipe will be in cut, and 4' will protrude above ground.



I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
