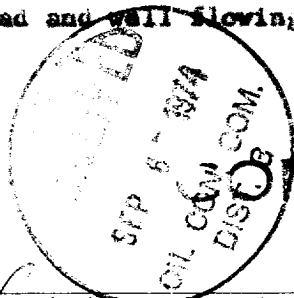

Spudded a 12-1/4" hole 4-29-74 and drilled to 121'. Reamed to 17-1/4" hole to 118'. 13-3/8" casing set at 118' with 125 sacks Class "A" cement on 4-30-74. Drilled 12-1/4" hole to 1518' with 9-5/8" casing set at 1518' with 500 sacks Class "A" cement followed by 75 sacks Class "A" Neat on 5-5-74. Drilled the 8-3/4" hole to a total depth of 6575' with 7" casing set at 6572' and DV tool at 4191'. Cemented first stage with 300 sacks Class "A" Pozmix and tailed in with 200 sacks Class "A" Neat on 5-24-74. Cemented second stage with 750 sacks 50:50 Pozmix plus 50 sacks Class "A" Neat. Cement circulated on all jobs. Drilled cement and DV tool and cleaned out well to PBD. Ran logs and perforated 6542-48' with 2 SPF. Acidized with 1,000 gallons regular mud acid. Breakdown and maximum pressure 2500 and average pressure 2300 psi. ISIP 1850 psi. AIR 3 BPM. Set a drillable bridge plug at 6532' and perforated 6400-6422' with 2 SPF. Pumped 2,000 gallons 28% HCl acid away with no breakdown pressure, 0 psi and AIR 4 BPM. Rippled up wellhead and well flowing.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.
