

Dear Mr. Ramey:

As you are aware, the Navajo Indian Irrigation Project is now under construction in San Juan County, New Mexico.

Much of the Project area is on lands covered by Federal 0il and Gas Leases. In some areas it will be necessary for us to request unorthodox well locations to prevent the installation of wells within cultivated areas or areas proposed for cultivation in the near future where they will interfere with cultivation and the operation of mechanical-move sprinkler irrigation systems. In other instances, where all of the land within a section is to be cultivated, the well locations should be such that they will cause the least possible amount of interference with farming activities.

It is necessary from time-to-time to request the approval of unorthodox oil and gas well locations within the exterior boundaries of the Navajo Indian Irrigation Project, as noted above. Your assistance in approving these locations will be greatly appreciated.

One such well location for which approval is requested is:

McHugh Bengal "B" No. 3 Section 2, T. 26 N., R. 12 W., N.M.P.M. 1250' FNL - 190' FEL


