Gentlemen:

Enclosed are Form-C-105 in quintuplicate WELL RECORD on the captioned well.

This well is completely equipped to produce oil with pumping unit, engine, lease lines and two 210 bbl tanks. It is an oil well. When I pump it a few hours it will make 3 to 5 bbls of oil, no water.

After shooting the well and cleaning it out to 1451' and re-running the pump, it has not pumped any oil as something is wrong with the pump and it will require pulling the rods and pump and making repairs. The hole is standing around 400' of oil. This was reported to you on March 14, 1962 by Form C-103.

I have no intentions of plugging this well, or abandoning it. It is temporarilty suspended because I have no-one up there to pump it, or to work with it as it is so isolated. I am negotiating with some people to take it over and produce it.

I have an opinion that this well will pump perhaps 10 bbls of oil, no water, per day when the pump is repaired and re-run. It may require additional cleaning out.
