Dear Jack:

Our well file for Tamamaco's Pound Ranch "B" #27 well, B-27-28N-1E indicates "water was encountered and the well was moved 100 feet south." It is also stated that 250 feet of 7" casing was cemented on this well and I presume that this 7" casing is still in the well.

Will you please file Form C-103 giving the present status of this well. If it is being used as a water well or if it has been taken over by the landowner as a water well an affidavit of conversion to water well should be filed, signed by both the operator and the landowner. If it is to be abandoned, a cement plug and marker should be installed in the top of the 7" casing.
