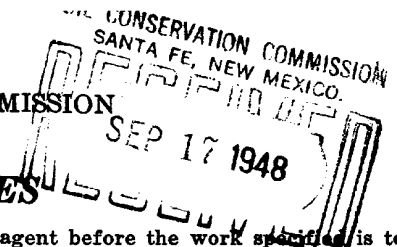

Plugging operations will consist of filling the hole with high viscosity and good weight mud. An approximately two foot long bridge plug will be set at a depth of thirty feet in the surface pipe and hole will be cemented to the top. A four inch in diameter marker will be placed in the hole and extend at least four feet above ground level and be cemented in place.
