

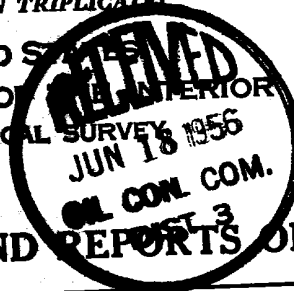

Plug No. 3 - In 7 7/8" hole used 40 sacks cement
from 1800' to 1800'

Plug No. 4 - Used 15 sacks cement in surface casing
with 4" pipe up 6' above ground. Cement in 2 5/8"
