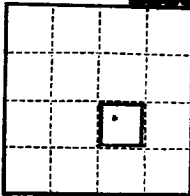

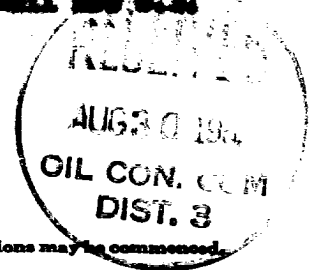

DETAILS OF WORK

Drilled to total depth of 1120 feet in 4-3/4" hole with air. Run logs. Landed 770 feet of 2", 2-3/8" 2-3/8" new flash-joint liner on bottom (1120') with top of liner at 350 feet (5" casing shoe at 300 feet) 4" liner is started 350 to 400 feet. Released rig to 25 p.m., 8-19-62. New oil was encountered while drilling at 350 feet on 8-19-62. Oil fill-up continued to total depth of 1120 feet. Run in 700 feet of 2-3/8" tubing. Will not O.I.L. tubing to move out rotary rig.
