Notice is hereby given of intention to drill the Memphis Tribal & Co. #1 to a total depth of approximately 4000'. 9-5/8", 210/lb., J-40, S&W surface casing will be set at 100' in 12 1/2" hole and cemented to surface. 7-7/8" hole will be drilled below surface cas. with mud to approximately 4000'. logs will be run at 4000'. 5 1/2", 140/lb., J-40 S&W casing will be set at 4000' and cemented with 500 cu. cu. Drilling will continue with air to total depth. Primary objective is oil/gas formation at 4000'. A 3" screened flush joint liner will be set at total depth if commercial production is obtained.
