DETAILS OF WORK

Casing Program:

10 3/4" at 170' with 125 sacks cement circulated to surface.
 7 5/8" at 2796' with 250 sacks cement.
 5 1/2" at 5000' with 150 sacks cement.

The E/2 of Section 32 is dedicated to this well.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

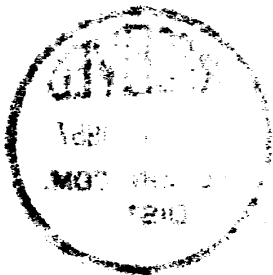

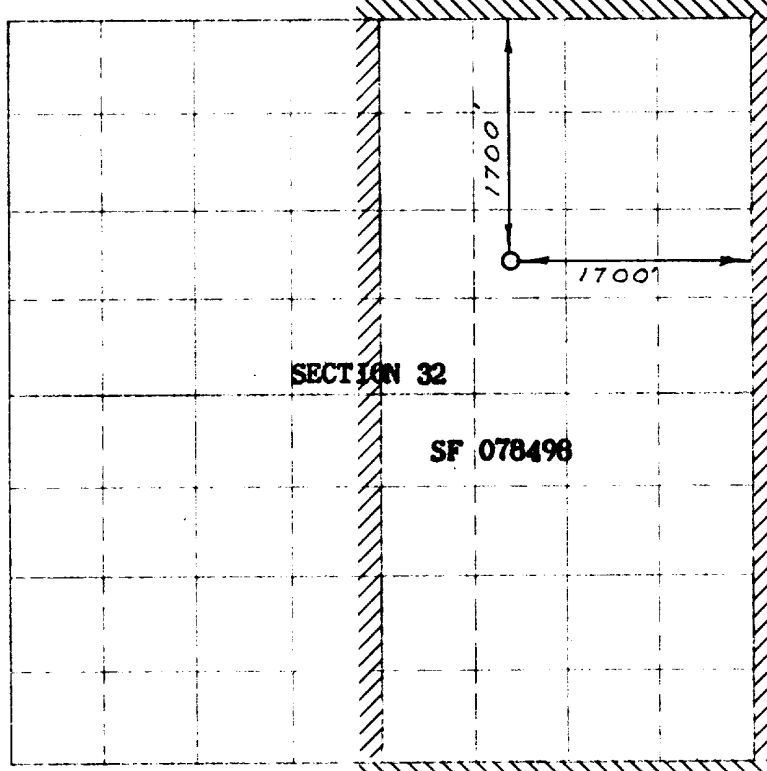

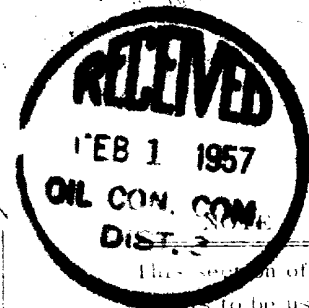
