ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A (c) El Paso Natural Gas Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on October 21, 1960, for permission to dually complete its San Juan 28-6 Unit Well No. 97 located in the NW/4 NE/4 of Section 35, Township 28 North, Range 6 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the Pictured Cliffs formation adjacent to the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool and the production of gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool.

Now, on this 21st day of November, 1960, the Secretary-Director finds:

(1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Sub-section 'c' of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;

(2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and

(3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.

(4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.

(5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, El Paso Natural Gas Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its San Juan 28-6 Unit Well No. 97 located in the NW/4 NE/4 of Section 35, Township 28 North, Range 6 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the Pictured Cliffs formation adjacent to the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool and the production of gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Section V, Rule 112-A.

Under the provisions of Rule 113-A (c) BI Base Natural
Gas Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Commission
Commission on October 31, 1960, for permission to jointly complete
the San Juan 28-E Unit Well No. 32 located in the NM\A NE\A of
Section 35, Township 28 North, Range 6 West, MM\PM, Rio Arriba
County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production
of gas from the Pictured Cities formation adjacent to the South
Blanco-Pictured Cities Pool and the production of gas from the
Blanco-Mesaberde Pool.

Now, on this day of November, 1960, the Secretary
Director finds:

(1) THAT application has been duly filed under the
provisions of Sub-section 'c' of Rule 113-A of the Commission's
Rules and Regulations;

(2) THAT satisfactory information has been provided
that all operations of office service have been duly completed;
and

(3) THAT no objection has been received within the
stated period as prescribed by said rule.

(4) THAT the proposed unit completion will not cause
any loss or impairment of existing pipelines.

(5) THAT the mechanics of the proposed unit completion
are feasible and consistent with good conservation practice.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

THAT the applicant herein, BI Base Natural Gas Company,
be and the same is hereby authorized to jointly complete the San
Juan 28-E Unit Well No. 32 located in the NM\A NE\A of Section 35,
Township 28 North, Range 6 West, MM\PM, Rio Arriba County, New
Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from
the Pictured Cities formation adjacent to the South Blanco-Pictured
Cities Pool and the production of gas from the Blanco-Mesaberde
Pool pursuant and consistent with the rules and regulations.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, THAT application shall complete
operations, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions
of Section V, Rule 113-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test Period for the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool or as directed by the Secretary-Director of the Commission.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained by the Commission for such further order or orders as may seem necessary or convenient for the prevention of waste and/or protection of correlative rights; upon failure of applicant to comply with any requirement of this order, the Commission may terminate the authority hereby granted and require applicant or its successors and assigns to limit its activities to regular single-zone production in the interests of conservation.

less grade fees upon completion and issuance of permit during
the Annual Registration Test period for the Biannual-Registration
book or as directed by the Secretary-Director of the Commission.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That registration of this
cause is hereby reserved by the Commission for such purpose
order or order as may seem necessary or convenient for the
removal of any or both of the following or corrective riders;
upon failure to comply with such requirement of this
order, the Commission may terminate the authority already issued
and require application for license or registration and assess
a fine of twenty five dollars to one thousand dollars to the
Commissioner to recover costs of production in the interests of
convenience.
