ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A(c) El Paso Natural Gas Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on November 30, 1960 for permission to dually complete its San Juan 28-S Unit Well No. 44, located in the SW/4 SW/4 of Section 27, Township 28 North, Range 5 West, NMMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the Blanco-MesaVerde Pool and the production of gas from the Basin-Dakota Pool.

NOW, on this 20th day of December, 1960, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Subsection 'c' of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, El Paso Natural Gas Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its San Juan 28-S Unit Well No. 44, located in the SW/4 SW/4 of Section 27, Township 28 North, Range 5 West, NMMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the Blanco-MesaVerde Pool and the production of gas from the Basin-Dakota Pool, through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Section V, Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test Period for the unit.
