

Subject: Workover of El Paso Natural Gas Company  
Well, San Juan Unit 28-7 No. 45,  
SW 27-28-7, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico

The above captioned well was worked over with completion on August 13, 1964. This workover consisted of plugging and abandoning the Pictured Cliffs zone and merely rerunning tubing in the Mesa Verde zone. In other words, this well is now a singly completed Mesa Verde well. This Mesa Verde zone is now ready to be produced through the pipeline and we desire this reconnection made as soon as possible.

No Initial Potential Test will be conducted on the Mesa Verde zone as the producing characteristics should be unchanged. Shut-in pressures measured on the Mesa Verde zone on August 20, 1964 were 702 psig on the casing and 701 psig on the tubing.

All Pictured Cliffs producing facilities may be retired from this location.
