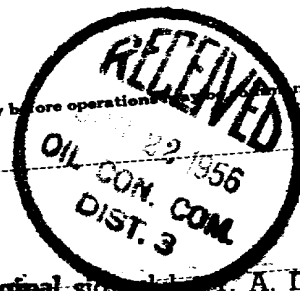

ARMY ROTATIONS AND REASSIGNMENTS

1. The purpose of this regulation is to provide for the efficient and economical rotation and reassignment of personnel in the Army. It is the policy of the Department of the Army to rotate personnel in the Army in order to provide them with a variety of experiences and to ensure that they are properly trained and equipped to perform their duties. This regulation sets forth the principles and procedures for the rotation and reassignment of personnel in the Army.

2. The rotation and reassignment of personnel in the Army shall be based on the following principles: (a) The rotation and reassignment of personnel shall be based on the needs of the Army and the interests of the personnel. (b) The rotation and reassignment of personnel shall be based on the principle of merit. (c) The rotation and reassignment of personnel shall be based on the principle of seniority. (d) The rotation and reassignment of personnel shall be based on the principle of geographical rotation. (e) The rotation and reassignment of personnel shall be based on the principle of functional rotation. (f) The rotation and reassignment of personnel shall be based on the principle of career development. (g) The rotation and reassignment of personnel shall be based on the principle of personal development. (h) The rotation and reassignment of personnel shall be based on the principle of family considerations. (i) The rotation and reassignment of personnel shall be based on the principle of health considerations. (j) The rotation and reassignment of personnel shall be based on the principle of other considerations.
