

This letter is to request the approval of an unorthodox gas well location in the Blanco-Mesa Verde field, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. Terrain conditions make an orthodox location unduly expensive. This well, San Juan 28-7 Unit #22 is to be located 1879 feet from the North line, 520 feet from the East line of Section 17, T28N, RTW, NMPM. This site is within the San Juan 28-7 Unit. This Unit is being operated entirely by El Paso Natural Gas Company. Since El Paso Natural Gas is its own offset operator in this case, no other operator has been notified.
