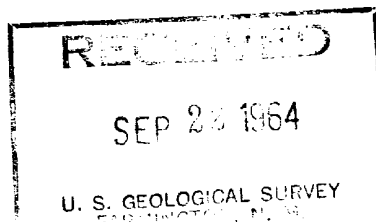

This well was drilled by Continental Oil Company and re-entered by W. Rodney De Villiers. Sunray DX, as record owner of the Lease, is responsible for plugging. T.D. 12,888', 13 3/8" OD, 48# csg. @ 831' w/700 sacks, 9 5/8" OD 40# & 47# csg. at 9412' w/800 sacks around bottom & 300 sacks thru stage collar at 4005'. Baker Model D pkr. at 7200'.

Unable to pull 2 3/8" OD EUE tubing out of Baker packer. Cut off tubing at 7169'. Spotted 50 sacks cement plug from 7169' to 7000' and pumped 5 sacks into packer. Pulled tubing. Shot off 9 5/8" OD csg. at 990'. Pulled up 7' and casing stuck; backed off at 326'. Spotted 50 sack plug 336' to 257'. Placed 25 sack cement plug from 30' to 0' and installed dry hole marker. Location ready for inspection.

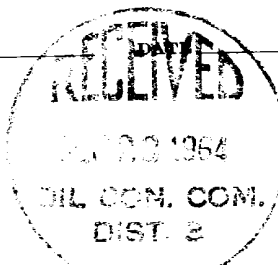

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices.
