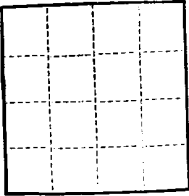

DETAILS OF WORK

Casing Program:

10 3/4" at 170' with 150 sacks cement circulated to the surface.
7 5/8" at 3793 with 250 sacks cement.
5 1/2" liner at 5963' with 300 sacks cement.

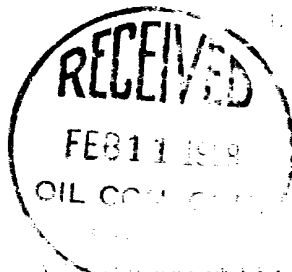
