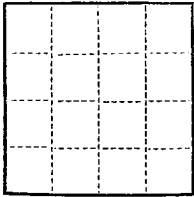

DETAILS OF WORK

It is intended to drill a well with rotary tools through the Mesaverde, drilling the pay with gas circulation, and to shoot the pay with two quarts N. N. G. per foot. Total depth 3707'.

Casing Program:

1-5/8" at 160' with 125 sacks regular cement circulated to surface.

7" at 4975' with 300 sacks regular cement.

The E/2 of Section 16 is dedicated to this well.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
