

DETAILS OF WORK

Propose to drill, 12-3/4" hole to 180', set 175' of 8-5/8" casing cemented with 125 sx 4% gel, then drill to 4060' and set 4058' of 5-1/2" casing, cemented with 125 sx 8% gel and 50 sx neat on bottom, then drill to total depth of 4343'. Gas zones will be approx. 4058-4173, 4201-4343, frac both zones simultaneously down casing using 20,000 gals w/1# sd/ gal, run casing and complete well.



I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operation may be commenced.




