It is intended to add pay to the Dakota formation of the subject well in the following manner:

Trip out of hole with tubing. Selectively reperforate the Dakota interval. Fracture stimulate the Dakota with sand and gelled water. Clean out to plug back total depth after fracture treatment. Rerun tubing. Return the well to production.
