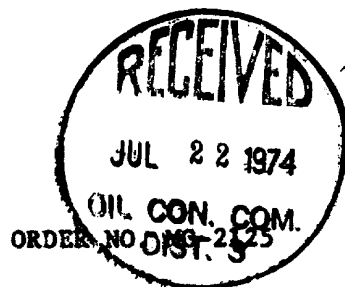


THE APPLICATION OF EL PASO NATURAL  
GAS COMPANY FOR A DUAL COMPLETION.



**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION**

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, El Paso Natural Gas Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on July 17, 1974, for permission to dually complete its San Juan 28-7 Unit Well No. 178, located in Unit P of Section 31, Township 28 North, Range 7 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool and from the Chacra Formation.

Now, on this 17th day of July, 1974, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that there are no other operators of offset acreage;
- (3) That the waiting period as prescribed by said rule may be waived;
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights; and
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

That the applicant herein, El Paso Natural Gas Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its 28-7 Unit Well No. 178, located in Unit P of Section 31, Township 28 North, Range 7 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool and from the Chacra Formation through parallel strings of 2 7/8 inch casing cemented in a common wellbore.

**PROVIDED HOWEVER,** That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

**PROVIDED FURTHER,** That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter.

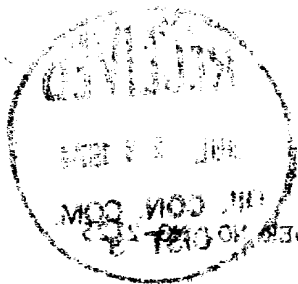
**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:** That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.

Under the provisions of Rule 111-A of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on July 1, 1974, for application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on July 1, 1974, for permission to dually complete the San Juan 18-7 Unit Well No. 178, located in Unit B of Section 31, Township 28 North, Range 7 West, NMM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Santa Blancia-Pictured Cliffs Pool and from the Chacra Formation.

Now, on this 17th day of July, 1974, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of this Rule of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that there are no other operators of offset wells;
- (3) That the waiting period as prescribed by said rule may be waived;
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor injure correlative rights; and
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consistent with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant named, El Paso Natural Gas Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete the 18-7 Unit Well No. 178, located in Unit B of Section 31, Township 28 North, Range 7 West, NMM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Santa Blancia-Pictured Cliffs Pool and from the Chacra Formation through parallel strings of 1 7/8 inch casing cemented in a common wellbore.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 111-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take proper-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause be hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
