Set RBP @ 6800'. Set packer and PT RBP to 1000psi. OK. PT backside to 1000psi. OK. POOH w/RBP, packer and 2 3/8" tbg. RIH w/2 3/8" tbg to 6970'. Spot 200 gals 7-1/2% HCL. Run GR/CCL from 6900-7030'. Reperforate Dakota 6953'-6974' W/4 JSPF. Set packer @ 6800'. PT backside to 500psi and monitor during acid job. Breakdown perfs @ 2500psi W/2% KCL WT, down tbg W/2000 gals 15% HCL at 5 BPM and 3000psi. Reset packer @ 6800'. Ran 6935' 2 3/8" tubing.

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to the following well No. 238 San Juan 28-7 Unit, SE/4SW/4 sec. 29, T. 28 N., R. 7 W., lease SF-078497, New Mexico and your Sundry Notice dated October 1, 1987, requesting approval to repair casing leak. If the work on the subject well has been completed you are required to submit a subsequent report. If the workover has not been completed, you are required to inform this office when the work is scheduled to be performed.

You have 30 days to comply with this order. The 30 days commences upon receipt of this letter or seven days from the date it is mailed, whichever is less. Failure to comply within the 30 days will result in strict enforcement of 43 CFR 3163.1.

Under provisions of 43 CFR 3165.3, you may request an Administrative Review of the orders described above. Such request, including all supporting documents, must be filed in writing within 20 business days of receipt of this notice and must be filed with the State Director, Bureau of Land Management, P. O. Box 1449, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87504-1449. Such request shall not result in a suspension of the order(s) unless the reviewing official so determines. Procedures governing appeals from instructions, orders or decisions are contained in 43 CFR 3165.4 and 43 CFR 4.400 et. seq.
