Thank you for your cooperation in this matter. If you need anything further, please advise.

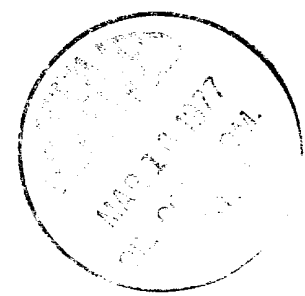
