Gentlemen:

By letter March 26, 1979, this office inquired of your drilling plans for Well No. 2 June located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. 33, T. 28 N., R. 3 W., NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, on Jicarilla Contract No. 84. Application for Permit to Drill had been approved August 2, 1977. Your reply indicated that you had no plans to immediately commence drilling operations, and this office notified you that approval of Application for Permit to Drill would be rescinded if drilling operations had not started by December 31, 1979.

Approval of Application for Permit to Drill is rescinded this date and application is returned herewith. Any construction of access road and well pad will have to be restored to the satisfaction of the Bureau of Indian Affairs.

If at some later date you decide to drill a well at this location, it will be necessary to file a new application with this office.


