Dear Ms. Maddox:

Reference is made to your application dated March 23, 1998, for a non-standard Blanco-Mesaverde infill gas well location in an existing standard 315.36-acre gas spacing and proration unit ("GPU") for said Blanco-Mesaverde Pool comprising Lots 3 and 4, the NW/4, and the N/2 SW/4 (W/2 equivalent) of Section 32, Township 28 North, Range 7 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, which is currently dedicated to the San Juan "28-7" Unit Well No. 77 (API No. 30-039-07219), located 800 feet from the South line and 1460 feet from the West line (Unit N) of said Section 32.

It is our understanding that the subject well to be considered in this application, the San Juan "28-7" Unit Well No. 252 (API No. 30-039-21653) was drilled in 1979 by El Paso Natural Gas Company and completed in the Basin-Dakota Pool at an unorthodox gas well location (approved by Division Administrative Orders NSL-1051, dated June 26, 1979, and NSL-1058, dated July 26, 1979) 790 feet from the North line and 1850 feet from the West line (Unit C) of said Section 32. At this time Conoco, Inc. intends to recomplete said wellbore by perforating up-hole into the Blanco-Mesaverde interval whereby both Basin-Dakota and Blanco-Mesaverde gas production will be commingled downhole under authority of Division Administrative Order DHC-1799, dated February 24, 1998.

Pursuant to the "General Rules for the Prorated Gas Pools of New Mexico/Special Rules and Regulations for the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool," as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, the location for the San Juan "28-7" Unit Well No. 252 is also unorthodox.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 2(d) of said special pool rules, the above-described unorthodox gas well location in the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool is hereby approved.

Further, all provisions of said Administrative Orders NSL-1051, NSL-1058, and DHC-1799 shall remain in full force and effect until further notice.

Dear Mr. Stogner:

Conoco's 28-7 Unit Well # 252 is located 750' FNL & 1850' FWL of Section 32, T-28-N, R-7-W, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. Because Section 32 is slightly irregular in size, this location is non-standard towards the interior centerline of Section 32 by 18'. Standard setback would be at least 790', the #252 is 771' from the centerline. Please note that this location does not encroach on the edge of the 28-7 unit, and that Conoco, Inc is the operator of all wells in the offset 320 acre proration units.

Conoco, Inc is in the process of recompleting the #252 to the Blanco Mesaverde. Conoco filed a NOI with the BLM to recomplete to the Mesaverde which was approved 1/30/98, an application to downhole commingle the Dakota and Mesaverde was also filed and approved by Administrative Order # DHC-1799. Conoco did not, however obtain an NSL for the Mesaverde. Since Section 32 appears to be a regular Section, and since 790' FNL and 1850' FWL would be a standard location in a "regular" Section; it was wrongly assumed that the well was at a standard location.

A copy of El Paos's application for a non-standard location as regards the Basin Dakota Pool is attached. A series of high cliffs in the northern half of the quarter section was cited as the reason for not being able to place the well at a standard location. Administrative Order # NSL-1051 and NSL-1058 (attached) was subsequently issued, approving El Paso's request.

Conoco was premature in performing the Mesaverde recompletion without obtaining approval for the pre-existing, non-standard location, and regrets this oversight. Conoco, Inc now respectfully requests that Administrative Order NSL – 1058 that was issued for the Dakota be amended to include the Mesaverde. This request is based on the following facts: the well is interior to the 28-7 unit, does not encroach on the unit edge, Conoco, Inc operates all wells in the offsetting proration units, and the fact that utilizing the existing wellbore to access Mesaverde reserves prevents economic waste.

Dear Mr. Ramey:

This is a request for administrative approval for an unorthodox gas well location in the Basin Dakota pool.

It is intended to locate the El Paso Natural Gas Company's San Juan 28-7 Unit #252 at 790' FNL and 1850' FWL of Section 32, T-28-N, R-7-W, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

It is necessary to locate this well at 1850', which leaves only 771' FEL, because a series of high steep cliffs cut through the northern half of the quarter section that the well is located in. These cliffs do not allow room at an orthodox distance from the west line of Section 32.

As this well is part of the San Juan 28-7 Unit, El Paso Natural Gas Company operates all offsetting proration units. Plats showing the proposed well location and the terrain of Section 32, along with an ownership plat, are attached.


