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THE APPLICATION OF EL PASO NATURAL GAS COMPANY FOR A DUAL COMPLETION

> ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A El Paso Natural Gaso Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservateor Division on June 23, 1980, for permission to dually complete its San Juan 28-6 Unit Well No. 28 A located in Unit D of Section 18, Township 28 North, Range 6 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Pictured Cliffs formation and from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool.

Now, on this 26th day of June, 1980, the Division Director finds:

- That application has been filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Division's Rules and Regulations;
- That satisfactory information has been provided that there are no other operators of offset acreage;
- That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights; and
- (4) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, El Paso Natural Gas Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its San Juan 28-6 Unit Well No. 28 A located in Unit D of Section 18, Township 28 North, Range 6 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Pictured Cliffs formation and from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.

NOTE: If the proposed multiple completion will result in an unorthodox well location and/or a non-standard proration unit in one or more of the producing zones, then separate application for approval of the same should be filed simultaneously with this application.
