## ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, El Paso Natural Gas Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division on October 23, 1980, for permission to dually complete its San Juan 28-6 Unit Well No. 10A located in Unit P of Section 25, ownship 28 North, Range 6 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the South Blanco Pictured Cliffs Pool and the Blanco Mesaverde Pool.

Now, on this 30th day of October, 1980, the Division Director finds:

- That application has been filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Division's Rules and Regulations;
- That satisfactory information has been provided that there are no other operators of offset acreage.
- That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights; and
- That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion re feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, El Paso Natural Gas Company, e and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its an Juan 28-6 Unit Well No. 10A located in Unit D of Section 25, ownship 28 North, Range 6 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, lew Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the South Blanco Pictured Cliffs Pool and the Blanco Mesaverde Rool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 12-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage ests upon completion and annually thereafter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause s hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the ivision may deem necessary.
