Valencia Canyon Unit No. 45 M

This is in regards to your telephone conversation with Johnny Barnett on December 16, 1986 concerning Valencia Canyon Unit No. 45M.

The first test failed due to high line pressure that the well could not produce against. A compressor on our gas gathering system also could not be used to produce the well because of insufficient gas volumes. I have called El Paso to set up another test this coming week. We will attempt to bypass the compressor and the master meter.

We are requesting that no penalties be assigned this well because of the extraordinarily high line pressures associated with system wide gas curtailments. If you concur, please sign and return a copy of this letter indicating your approval.
