This is a request for administrative approval for an unorthodox gas well location in the Basin Dakota Pool.


It is intended to locate the El Paso Natural Gas Company's San Juan 28-5 Unit #89E at 1190' from the South line and 1745' from the West line of Section 9, T-28-N, R-5-W, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

Extremely rough terrain in the form of steep cliffs and a non-standard proration unit makes it impossible to build an orthodox gas well location in the northwest corner of Section 1.

A copy of this application is being submitted to all offset operators by certified mail with a request that they furnish your Santa Fe office with a Waiver of Objection, and return one copy to this office.

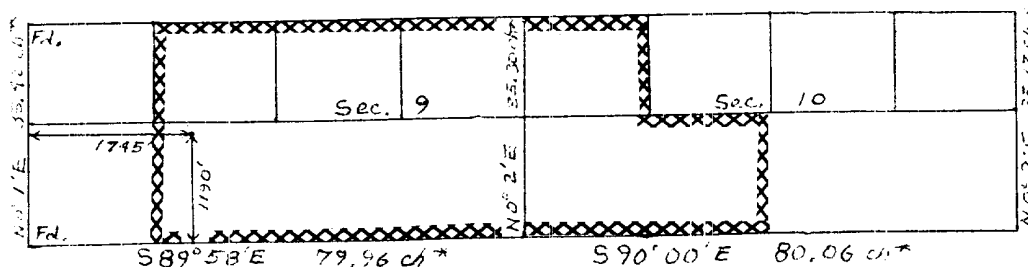

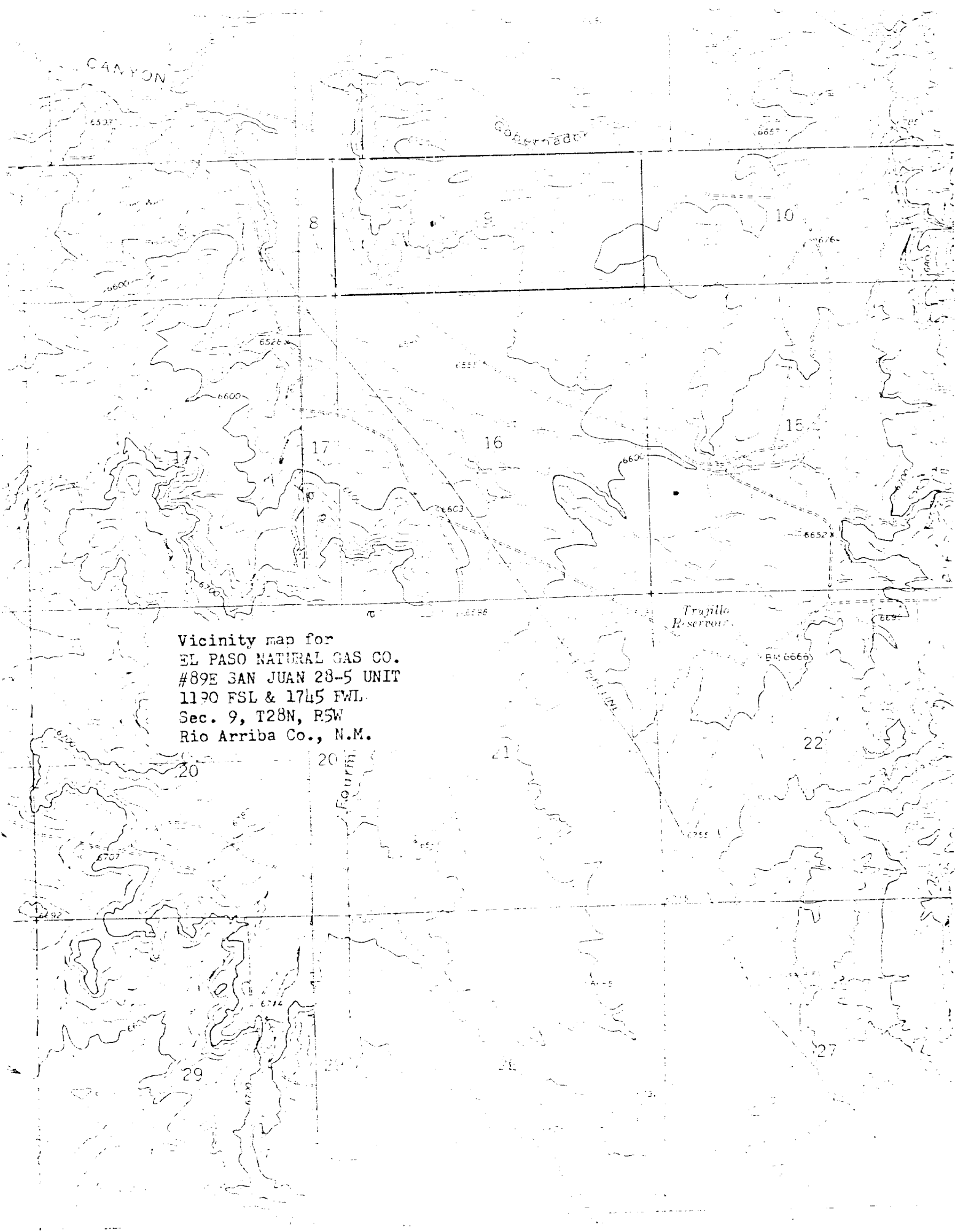

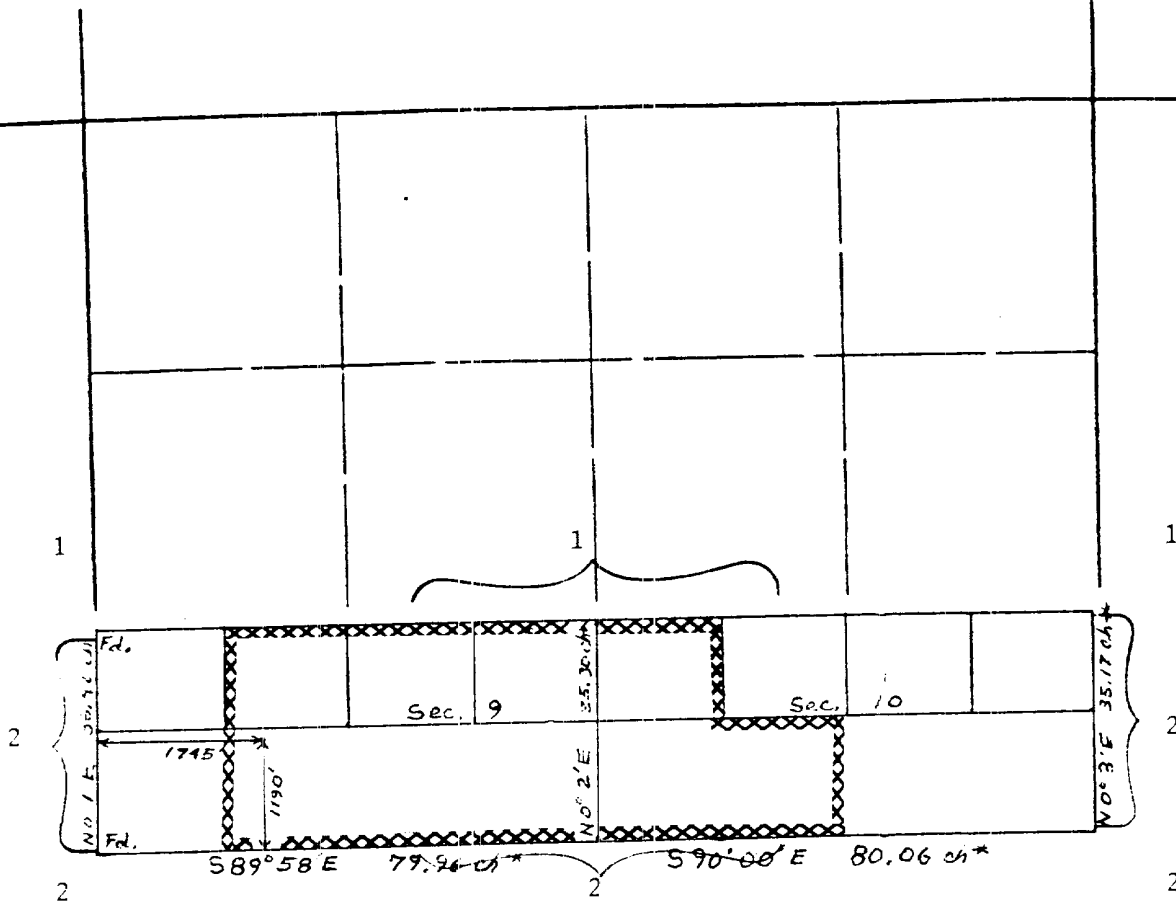
