This is a request for administrative approval for an unorthodox gas well location in the Basin Dakota Pool.


It is intended to locate the El Paso Natural Gas Company's San Juan 28-5 Unit #96E at 1270' from the South line and 700' from the West line of Section 11, T-28-N, R-5-W, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

The existence of steep cliffs and an existing gas well in the SW/4 of this section makes it impossible to build an orthodox gas well location.

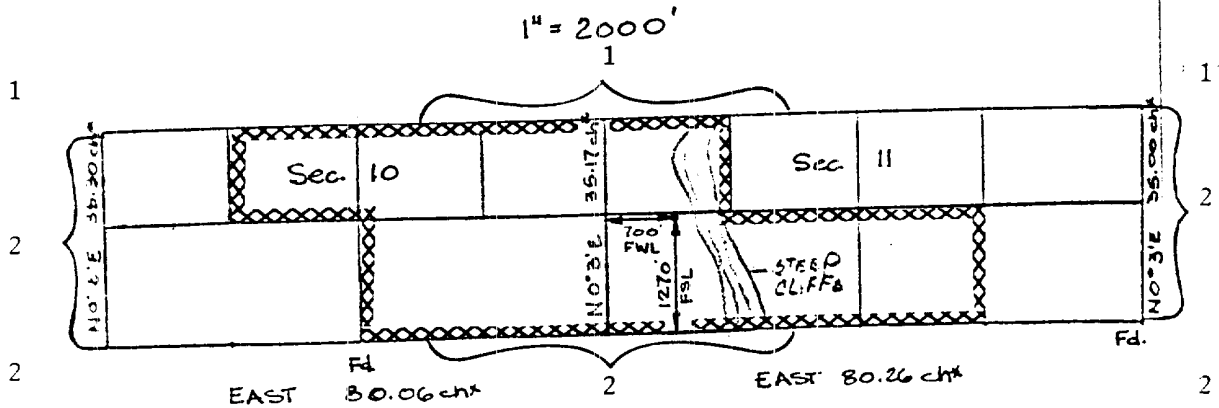

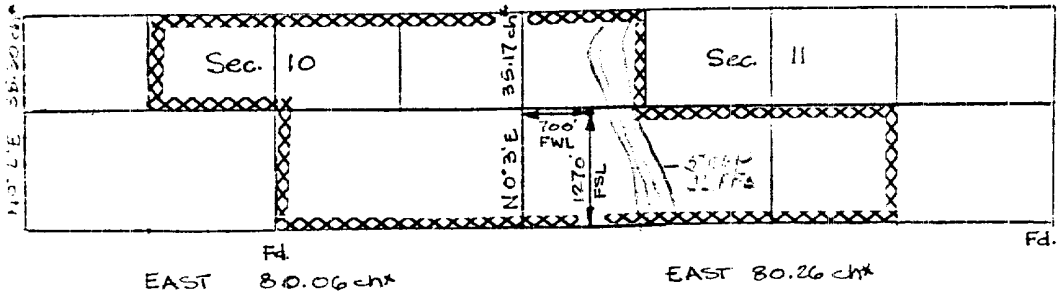

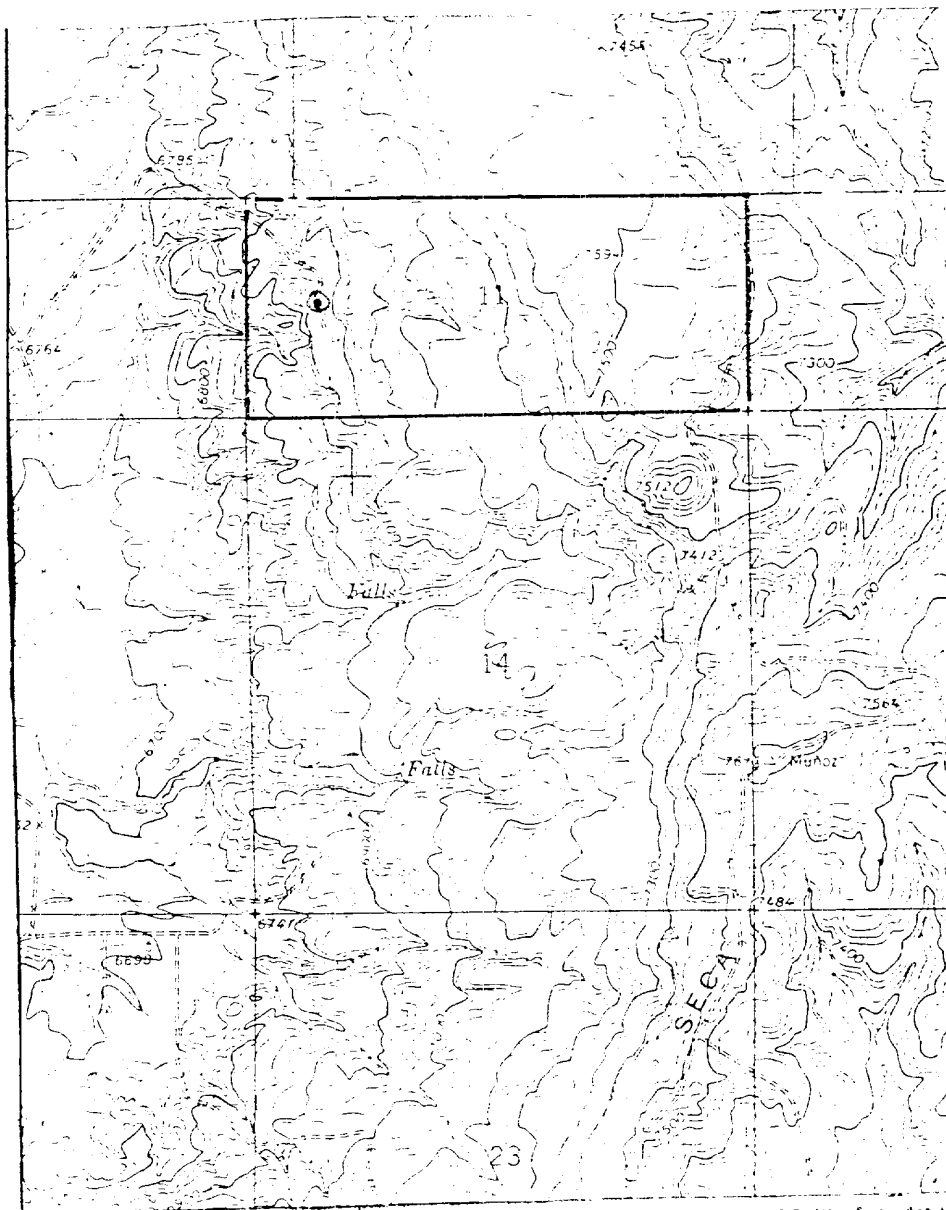
