Enclosed is one approved copy of Unit Communitization Agreement (CA) NMNM 96751, involving 324.63 acres of Federal land (160.00 acres in lease NMSF-079049-B, and 164.63 acres in lease NMSF-079051), in Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. This acreage comprises a 324.63 acre spacing unit for the San Juan 28-6 Unit No. 466 well on lease NMSF-079049-B.

The agreement communitizes all rights as to natural gas and associated liquid hydrocarbons producible from the Fruitland Coal Formation in the Lots 1-2, NE $\frac{1}{4}$, N $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 34, T. 28 N., R. 6 W., NMPM, and is effective March 27, 1991. This CA shall remain in force and effect for a period of 2 years and for as long as communitized substances are, or can be, produced from the communitized area in paying quantities, and subject lands are not included in a participating area. You are requested to furnish all interested principals with appropriate evidence of this approval.

If this well is producing, this approval requires the submission of a Payor Information Form MMS-4025 to the Minerals Management Service (MMS) within 30 days (30 CFR 210.51). Please notify the designated payor or payors (purchasers, working interest owners, or others) as soon as possible regarding this requirement. Any production royalties that are due must be reported and paid within 90 days of the Bureau of Land Management's approval date or the payors will be assessed interest for late payment under the Federal Oil and Gas Royalty Management Act of 1982 (30 CFR 218.54).
