Dear Mr. Carlile:

Our records indicate that you are the operator of the following well located in Rio Arriba County, New Mexico:

- 1) No. 428 San Juan 28-7 Unit, 1060' FNL & 820' FEL sec. 23, T. 28 N., R. 7 W., Lease NMSF-079290A. Well has not produced since prior to January, 1997.
