As shown by ~~Some 6-1811~~ filed with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission, Astec, New Mexico, by Hamilton Investment Company on July 5, 1961, the Hamilton Investment Company moved the Western Drilling Company's tools on to the Penn Building Well No. 1 and drilled the same through the Greenhorn Line. FORMATION RECORD

Western Drilling Company, Inc. of Lubbock, Texas, moved its cable tools to Penn Building #1 Well, located 330 feet from west line and 2310 feet from north line, Sec. 33, T. 28N, R. 4E, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, on June 2, 1961 for the purpose of drilling well on to test Greenhorn Line.

Finished rigging up June 4th. Began cleaning out cavings at 1211'. Began making new hole at noon, June 5, 1961. Log of new hole is as follows:

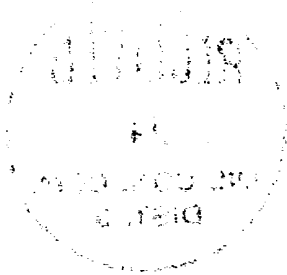

As shown by Dean Gold filed with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission, Astec, New Mexico, by Hamilton Investment Company on July 5, 1961, the Hamilton Investment Company moved the Western Drilling Company's tools on to the Penn Building Well No. 1 and drilled the same through the Greenhorn Lina. At that depth, Spill Brothers, Landowners, took over the well (at 1435 feet) and drilled it to 1577 feet, T. B. Hamilton Investment Company's interest in this well ended at a depth of 1435 feet. What was done from there on down was at the direction of Spill Brothers entirely.

4. Spill Brothers ran 42 in. of 4 1/2" 9.5# J55 New casing to a depth of 1435 feet, according to Western Drilling Company's Daily Drilling Report. After casing was set, Spill Brothers had Western Drilling Company drill well to a total depth of 1577 feet, and it seems, made an excellent fresh water well in the Dakota Sandstone.

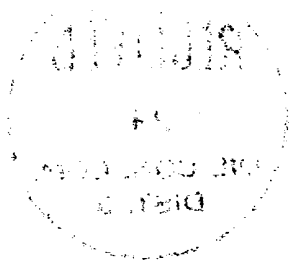
