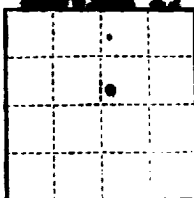

DETAILS OF WORK

Notice is hereby given of intention to drill the Florilla Tribal 8-15-1 to a total depth of approximately 4800'. 9 5/8", 40#/ft. J-55 SBC surface csg will be set at 100' in 12 1/4" hole and cemented to surface. Drilling will continue in 7 7/8" hole with mud to approximately 4450'. Logs will be run at 4450'. 5 1/2", 14#/ft. J-55 SBC csg will be set at 4450' & cemented with 200 cu. regular neat cement. Drilling will continue with air to total depth. Primary objective is Gallup formation at 4450'. A 3" slotted flush joint liner will be set at total depth if commercial production is obtained.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be STARTED.
