Reference is made to your letter of December 29, 1960, wherein you request authority to complete your Government Doublit Well No. 6, located in the SW/4 SW/4 of Section 34, Wownship 27 North, Range 11 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, with 4%-inch OD non-upset casing and produce the Dakota hydrocarbons through said casing string as a tubingless completion.

Anasmuch as you expect that the Dakota will produce with a gas-liquid ratio in the neighborhood of 100,000 to one, there should be no production problem or waste encountered by your proposed completion.
