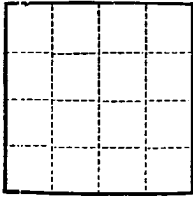

DETAILS OF WORK

It was originally intended to finally complete this well in the Mesa Verde and Pictured Cliffs formations as the El Paso Natural Gas Co. Bulack No. 19-C (PH). Results of stimulative treatment have shown the Pictured Cliffs formation to be non-commercial, however. It is, therefore, intended to squeeze off the existing Pictured Cliffs perforations at 2744-2795' with 100 sacks cement and complete the well in the Mesa Verde formation only, with name changed to Bulack No. 19-C. The enclosed well location plat has been reissued to show corrected dedicated acreage (N/2 of Section 33 is dedicated to this well).
