Subject well may be connected to a gas gathering system to be produced for communications test as outlined below.

When the shut-in pressure is stabilized or after seven days, which ever is earlier, the Debota zone may be produced into a pipeline while the Gallup zone remains shut-in. This production shall continue for one week during which time pressures shall be taken with a deadwalght gauge of both flowing and shut-in zones. A minimum of three flowing pressures shall be taken, each separated by at least 24 hours, and the last being measured on the seventh or eighth day of production. Other pressures may be taken if desired.

This office shall be notified of the test prior to the initial production.
