Dear Mr. Porter:

This is to request administrative approval of an unorthodox location to be located in the West Kutz Extension Pictured Cliff Pool.

The well, our Huerfano Unit No. 82 is to be located 1150' from the North line and 592.3' from the West line of Section 33, Township 27 North, Range 10 West, N.M.P.M., San Juan County, New Mexico. The major part of the north west quarter of the section, which is dedicated to this well, consists of steep shale cliffs which would make the cost of an orthodox location extremely expensive.

This well is to be a Pictured Cliffs completion and since El Paso Natural Gas is the operator of the Huerfano Unit and the NE/4 of Section 32, Township 27 North, Range 10 West is within the Huerfano Unit, the approval of other operators has not been sought.

I am enclosing two copies of the Certified Well Location Plat sketching terrain conditions and two copies of our Intention to Drill.
