DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

The well was spudded at 10:00 P.M., March 31, 1953. On April 1, 1953, 8 5/8" casing was landed at 110 feet and cemented with 75 sacks of cement. Cement plug down at 2:00 A.M., April 1, 1953. At 2:00 A.M., April 2, 1953, casing and water shut-off were tested at 500 pounds for 30 minutes, with no drop in pressure. Twenty-six feet of solid cement were drilled in bottom of pipe and water shut-off was again tested at 500 pounds for 30 minutes. There was no drop in pressure during this test and drilling operations were resumed.
