Accordingly, notice is given to you as the operator of a tract offsetting the proposed non-standard gas pro-ration unit and as operator of the tracts described as SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 30, Township 28 North, Range 10 West, NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 31, Township 28 North, Range 10 West, and NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 36, Township 26 North, Range 10 West, San Juan, County, New Mexico.
